LOOKING AHEAD: OUR 2026 OBJECTIVES



Academics: Sponsorship & Scholarships

Education remains at the heart of our work. Beyond ensuring 27 children receive a wholesome education, we are taking a new step in 2026 by expanding access to university and tertiary scholarships for youth seeking to continue their studies and prepare for purposeful, sustainable futures.



Advance Disability Inclusion & Family Support

Recognizing that disability impacts the whole family, we plan to reach at least 100 caregivers with training and encouragement that promotes compassionate care, restores dignity, and builds supportive community for families of children with disabilities.



Improve Access to Safe Water

In 2026, we plan to continue our pursuit of ensuring safe, clean water by installing three water collection points in key community spaces such as schools and churches, increasing access to safe water across multiple sub-counties.



Strengthen Youth Empowerment & Discipleship

Through discipleship, mentorship, and outreach, we seek to reach at least 1,000 youth with the Word of God and life-giving teachings rooted in this year's theme, *Seasons*, equipping them to navigate life with faith, wisdom, and purpose.



Scale Skills Training & Social Enterprises

In 2026, we desire to grow our skills training program by acquiring five additional sewing machines and launching a tailoring social enterprise that empowers individuals with dignity, employable skills, and entrepreneurial opportunity.



Develop Safe & Sustainable Community Infrastructure

We will strengthen our foundation by securing the community center and constructing a building that supports skills development, therapy, administration, and the long-term growth of the ministry.

- **\$40/month** - A primary-aged child can attend school and receive a quality, holistic education.
- **\$40/month** - A child with a disability can receive specialized care, physical therapy, and the resources and support needed to meet immediate needs and pursue long-term growth.
- **\$200/month** - Physiotherapy services can be provided twice monthly for children with disabilities and community members.
- **\$100/month** - Local schools can be supported through book clubs and literacy initiatives that encourage a love of reading and learning.
- **\$20/month** - A women's group can be facilitated with resources that encourage personal, professional, and spiritual growth.
